PROGRAMME CONTENT

Service Design Strategies and Innovations (SDSI) is a jointly organised Erasmus Mundus master's programme with a focus on service design, management and business. We educate versatile service innovators who can enable change in public and private organisations through strategic design, management and creative leadership. We have strong connections to industry. Students have opportunities to work with real industry partners on study topics and projects.

During the studies, you will learn about the service sector, which plays a crucial role in the organisation of our society and how we face and respond to societal challenges. Services are provided over time, with their provision and consumption often occurring simultaneously. Characterised by interaction touchpoints that are informed by the behaviours and experiences of users, customers, and service providers, service design answers to quality control and innovation management, which remain challenging to service organisations. We will equip you with the knowledge and skills to be prepared for an uncertain future through the application of service design. You will know how to identify and satisfy unmet needs in a wide range of sectors.

Upon graduation, you will:

- Become a versatile professional with an agile mindset
- Transform existing service design concepts by integrating research-based user needs and organisational strategies
- Apply holistic approaches and user-centred design principles
- Understand social, economic, and technological contexts in which private and public services function
- Be an organisational change facilitator
- Have grown into leadership roles through experience

SDSI is organized in co-operation between the University of Lapland, the Art Academy of Latvia, the Stockholm School of Economics in Riga, and the Estonian Academy of Arts. The programme includes study periods in Kuldīga (Latvia), Tallinn (Estonia) and Rovaniemi (Finland). Graduates will be awarded with multiple degrees: Master of Arts (Art and Design) by the University of Lapland, Master of Design by the Art Academy of Latvia and Master of Arts by the Estonian Academy of Arts.
